

Supply Lists:

Rocky River Middle School 8th Grade School Supply List

The Eighth Grade Team has generated a list of supplies that students will need for the school year. All of these supplies can be stored in the students' lockers until they are needed. This list is broken down by subject area where appropriate.

GENERAL SUPPLIES

6 spiral notebooks, 6 2- pocket folders, 3 dry-erase markers (not yellow), pencils, eraser, blue pens, red pens, loose leaf paper, highlighter, scissors, 3 X 5 index cards, 1 pkg. construction paper, ruler, colored pencils, book covers, 1 box of tissues for homeroom, Rocky River Public Library card with PIN number. Highly recommended: Each student has their own Travel Drive so that they will be able to carry computer files from home to school.

ALGEBRA

Two 8.5 X 11 inch one-subject spiral notebooks (lined or graph), a 1.5 or 2 inch binder, 5 dividers, graph paper, TI-83 or TI-84 graphing calculator, non-graphing, scientific calculator, straight edge, Scotch tape.

MATH

A 1.5 or 2 inch binder, 5 dividers, graph paper, TI-83 or TI-84 graphing calculator, non-graphing, scientific calculator, straight edge, scotch tape.

FRENCH

A 1.5 or 2 inch binder, one 2-pocket folder, and a box of klennex.

SCIENCE

2 composition notebooks – Quad ruled, 9 ¾" X 7 ½", 100 sheets, colored pencils.

SPANISH

Spanish dictionary, 1" binder, 2 posters.

UNIFIED ARTS

Health	One 2-pocket folder.
Industrial Technology	One 2- pocket folder.
Fitness	Fitness uniform (Available from the school if you do not have one from last year)
Applied Communication	One 2- pocket folder.
Art	Colored pencils and eraser.
General Music	One 2- pocket folder.

7th Grade School Supply List

The 7th Grade team has generated a list of supplies that students will need for the school year. All of these supplies can be stored in the students' lockers until they are needed. The list is broken down by subject area and then by teacher within each subject area if individual teachers have different requests. These supplies are due by the second week of school.

Homeroom:

One box of Kleenex (200 count)
One roll of clear contact paper.

For all classes students will need:

Pens and pencils, glue stick, scissors, colored pencils, loose leaf paper, scotch tape, set of 4 dry erase markers, RR Public Library card – with PIN number

Science:

3-subject spiral notebook with pockets, two pocket folder, 3x5 index cards

Social Studies:

One pack of 4 x 6 index cards, spiral one subject notebook, pocket folder

English:

One inch three ring binder with inside front pocket, 3 dividers, Post-It Notes, 4x6 index cards (4th quarter), highlighters (ample supply needed throughout year)

Math:

Graph paper, plastic zipper pocket containing a compass and a protractor, 1½ inch 3 ring binder, 8 dividers, a TI-83 Plus or TI-84 Plus graphing calculator, OAT approved calculator (one purchased for 6th grade), red ballpoint pens, metric/customary ruler

Reading:

2-pocket folder, spiral notebook

Spanish:

Spanish/English pocket dictionary (i.e. – Bantam, etc), 4 x 6 inch index cards, 2 inch metal ring, one hole punch, 2 pocket folder, one inch 3 ring binder

French:

1½ inch 3 ring binder, 3 dividers, 2 pocket folder

Unified Arts:

Health: one 2-pocket folder

Industrial Technology: one 2-pocket folder

Career Exploration: one 2-pocket folder

Fitness: fitness uniform (available from the school for \$16.00) if you do not have one

Art: colored pencils and eraser

General:

It is highly recommended that each student has their own Flash Drive or Pen Drive so that they will be able to carry computer files from home to school. These are generally available from office supply or tech stores for \$6 to \$12 each.

The Sixth Grade Team has generated a list of supplies that students will need for the school year. All of these supplies can be stored in the students' lockers until they are needed. The list is broken down by subject area.

General:

A 200 count or larger box of tissues to be given to your first period teacher and a Rocky River Public Library card with PIN number. It is highly recommended that each student have their own Flash Drive or Pen Drive so that he/she will be able to carry computer files from home to school. These are generally available from office supply or tech stores for \$6 to \$12 each depending on the memory size.

Science Classes:

A 3-subject notebook with pockets – will probably need 2 or 3 more during the school year
Pencil or pen

Social Studies Classes:

A 3-prong pocket folder, loose-leaf paper, colored pencils

Language Arts Classes:

A 1 to 2-inch hard cover 3 ring binder with pockets just for Language Arts, 5 separate folders with pockets and prongs, 5 dividers for binder, loose-leaf paper, blue and black pens, sticky notes, index cards, colored pens or pencils for editing

Math Classes:

One 1½ inch binder, one three-whole punched plastic pocket folder, plenty of pencils, a fraction capable scientific calculator i.e. TI30XA (Texas Instrument), a dry erase marker, a multicolored pen, a plastic pocket pouch, a pack or pad of graph paper, and 8 plastic dividers.

Unified Arts Classes:

Health: one 2-pocket folder

Computer Technology: one 2-pocket folder

Fitness: fitness uniform (available from the school for \$16.00)

Art: colored pencils and eraser

General Music: one 2-pocket folder

The 6th grade staff suggests the use of notebooks or binders with built in folders for each class as opposed to a trapper. It is our experience that trappers become a hindrance to organization. This is obviously not true for all students so we are not disallowing the use of trappers, only suggesting an alternative. We also suggest a large claw clip or giant paper clip for use with the plan book. White out is not allowed in school.
