NOTES about Today's Game: North Olmsted (0-1-0) lost to Amherst (4-1) on Wednesday. This is the season opener for River. Last year's game was a thriller with River taking a 2-0 lead and with 5 minutes left in the game, North Olmsted tied the game but River came back to win it on a Hannah McCue goal with 2 minutes left in the game. The 2011 RRGs team lost 11 seniors including the four senior captains of which included one of the best sweepers in River history, Morgan Berg; best goalies, Kim Leitch; and best midfielders and first team All-American, Sarah Molina.

Returning this year are last year's leading goal scorers Grace Bennett (19) and Abby Elinsky (12) and last year's leading assists leaders McKenna Klodnick (15) and Hallie McCue (12). Sara Connelly (Jr) takes over the goalkeeping duties for the Varsity whereas the JV keeper for the previous 2 years, she had only 5 loses total. Six other lettermen return: Liesl Fahrenkopf, Meghan Ittu, Megan Killeen, Maddie Russell, Eva Schneider and Grace Tigue. New to the Varsity is Katie Kocher, Megan Moore, Jessica Lekstutis, Amanda Oster, McKenna Turk, Sydney Hamker, Jillian Krebs, Jessica Vitou, Sophia Braun and Emily Soltes.

River added 15 Freshmen to its ranks and a new JV coach, Jeff Kaurmann.
