Superintendent's Report

- Ms. Anderson reported that:
 - A team of 6-7 grade 5 students will participate in this year's NASA Young Astronaut Day on November 5, 2016 at NASA Glenn Research Center. Kensington gifted intervention specialist Meredith Muccio will organize and lead this new adventure.
 - Frank O'Grady, tutor at the middle school, was invited to be the "lead Teacher" for the National History Day 2017 Normandy Scholars history adventure to France in June 2017.
 - Frank O'Grady was recognized by the Ohio Lottery as the October Partners in Education/Teacher of the Month.

- Four Rocky River teachers recognized at the state level for being in the top 100 of their class for their Resident Educator Summative Assessment (RESA) performance: Kelly Riolo, Allison Paetz, Ericka Ghazoul and Gina Boguslawski. These teachers were recognized at a reception at the Ohio Statehouse, where they were also addressed by State Superintendent Paolo DeMaria and acclaimed educator and author Charlotte Danielson. According to Matt Verber, Executive Director of Policy and Advocacy at Educopia, the organization that created and delivers the RESA, Rocky River had a disproportionate number of invitees to the event. Of the 20 Rocky River teachers who have taken the RESA over the past 3 years, 6 scored in the top 100 of their class. Between 2,500 and 4,000 resident educators take the RESA each year.
- Ms. Norman reported the Co-Taught Class Survey Results for 2016, and that the RRCSD preschool
 program officially received a five-star rating by the Step Up to Quality program (Ohio's tiered five-star
 quality rating & improvement system).
- Dr. Foley reported on the exciting projects being worked on in the RRHS Makerspace.
- Dr. Shoaf reported on the Future Think Enrollment Projections and the 16-17 enrollment numbers to date.
