Committee Reports

Curriculum Committee – Mrs. Rounds

- Mrs. Rounds advised the group that the Curriculum Committee would not be meeting in January. January 24th marks the end of the second quarter and there will be benchmarking this month at Goldwood Primary School, Kensington Intermediate School and Rocky River Middle School.
- Ms. Anderson provided a list of proposed fees to the Committee for review.
- Ms. Anderson will have copies of the proposed Course Catalogs for the 2014/2015 school year at the Board Meeting on January 16th.

Facilities Committee – Mr. Milano

- There were no change orders for the Committee to review this month.
