Student Assignments

More Kensington Facts

- All students at Kensington receive a plan book each year which is utilized to organize assignments and homework.
- All of the teachers at Kensington are "Highly Qualified" as established by the Ohio Department of Education.
- Third grade students receive letter grades for the first time on his or her report cards.
- As part of Ohio's Reading Guarantee Law, students must pass the Ohio's state reading assessment in order to be promoted to the fourth grade. Students are given several opportunities to meet the promotion requirement. Kensington students participate is state testing for language arts and math. These important tests assist in identifying learning success as well as learning targets needing improvement.
