_____ has been selected for participation in our Title 1 Reading Intervention Program. This is a federally funded program we are fortunate to have received here at Goldwood Primary School. Your child will receive his or her initial instruction in the area of Foundations (our phonics program) in the classroom. Review of these skills and reading reinforcement through our Foundations Program will be in our Title 1 Reading Intervention small group setting. Your child may also receive Leveled Literacy Instruction which focuses on reading, comprehension and written expression. Small group intervention groups are approximately 30 -60 minutes of daily instruction. Your child's classroom teacher, our principal, our coordinator of learning resources and our intervention staff will work closely together to build a strong reading foundation for your child.

We feel that each family plays an important role in the success of their child in school. *Daily* reading together at home and visiting the local library are two valuable ways to support your child's reading efforts.
