Costumes: You will need to supply the following items...

KNIGHTS:

Long-sleeved black shirt

Black flat shoes or dance shoes (no slip-ons)

Girls: Thick black tights or leggings

1 pair of regular black socks

Boys: 1 pair of black knee high socks

(boys will be provided with black shorts or they can bring in black jogging pants)

DAMSELS:

Camisole or a tank top (especially the girls who change costumes)

Black tights

Black flat shoes or dance shoes (no slip-ons)
