Frequently Asked Questions



What is the Options Program?

Designed for Upperclassmen only, the Options Program is an exercise in learning the proper and wise use of time.

Who is Eligible?

Juniors or Seniors only, who are earning good grades and who adhere to the RRHS Discipline Code. The administration reserves the right to determine a student's eligibility.

What Options Are Available?

1. Lunch Pass Option: Student may leave the building for lunch.
2. Home Pass Option: If study hall is scheduled during Period 1 or 7, the student may either stay home for Period 1 – arriving by 8:50 a.m., entering through Wagar lobby doors; **OR** go home Period 7, leaving immediately at the end of Period 6. (Students must be in school 5-1/2 hours per day.)

How do I Obtain Lunch Pass Option and/or Home Pass Option?

1. Have your parent/legal guardian sign the Options Program Application.
2. Have a current Rocky River High School identification card.
3. Submit signed Options Program Application to Administration office for approval.

Is it possible to be removed from the Option Program?

Any student who violates any part of the agreement that he/she signs to obtain Option privileges puts himself/herself at in danger of losing those privileges. Other reasons include:

1. Excessive tardiness to school – in the morning or following lunch.
2. Unexcused class absences.
3. Driving an underclassman from school at lunch.
4. Parental request.
5. Administrative prerogative.
