FEES

GRADES 6, 7 & 8	\$51.00 for basic school fees that include student plan book/handbook and general supplies
8 th GRADE HONORS SCIENCE	\$15.00 general fee for all 8 th grade students enrolled in Honors Science for High School Credit.
WORLD LANGUAGE	\$18.00 for a French or Spanish workbook. French- Only 7th grade students must purchase a workbook and NEW 8th grade students coming in. Returning 8th graders DO NOT need a workbook. Spanish- All students taking Spanish will be required to purchase a workbook.
FITNESS	\$16.00 for gym uniform (\$8.00 shirts/\$8.00 shorts) if a student does not already have a uniform.
ATHLETICS	\$47.00 for students involved in each athletic team to cover the costs of bus transportation. PAYMENT OF THIS FEE IS DUE AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH ATHLETIC SEASON TO THE COACH. <u>DO NOT PAY THIS FEE WHEN PICKING UP YOUR SCHEDULE.</u>

*All 7th and 8th grade students will need to have a Texas Instruments TI-83 Plus or TI-84 Plus graphing calculator. We recommend the TI-84 Plus if you are purchasing for the first time. These can be purchased by the student for approximately \$120.00 or **leased from the school for \$20.00 when you pay school fees.** The student is responsible for the calculator and it must be returned in working order. If the calculator is not returned in working order or in the same condition as it was leased, the student will be responsible for replacing the calculator by either paying \$100.00 towards a replacement or supplying a like calculator to the school.

Since the student will be using this calculator for their classes in high school, we recommend that each student purchase their own calculator. It is essential that your son or daughter permanently mark their calculators with their name in case it is lost or stolen.
