## Solo & Ensemble Information

Entry Deadline - Friday, January 12, 2018

Performance Date: Saturday, February 24, 2018

**Location:** Fairview High School (3 miles away, 10 minutes)

**Time:** Specific times will be announced after the master schedule is completed. The contest chairman will send the specific times a week in advance of the contest. The events happen sometime between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Generally, solos take place in the morning and ensembles take place in the afternoon. **If you know of a potential conflict, please indicate what and when that is on the sign-up sheet.** 

Students may perform one solo, and participate in one ensemble, unless more events are OK'd by Mr. Komperda. Additionally, students may play piano, guitar or string solos.

Students <u>must</u> commit to rehearsing with Mr. Komperda/Mrs. Quimby for coaching after school.

The contest requires entry fees of \$10.00 per solo and \$5.00 per member of an ensemble (i.e. Trio would be \$15, Quartet would be \$20 total). Solo performances (with the exception of piano solos and most percussion solos) **require** a piano accompanist. Students may arrange this with their private lesson teacher, or an accompanist can be provided for you for a \$30 fee (includes preparation, 1-2 rehearsals and the performance)

Transportation to and from the contest is the responsibility of the performers. Car-pooling is recommended. You will receive a list of the students participating in the contest.

Breakfast/Lunch/Snacks are available in the cafeteria.

Parents **are** invited to attend the performances of any students at the contest.

No Video or Audio recording is permitted in the performance rooms.

RRMS will be DISQUALIFIED if the judges see any recording devices used.

There is no required music list but no pop, jazz, Broadway, or light music is allowed. Mr. Komperda, Mrs. Quimby and students' own private teachers will help them select appropriate music.

Performers <u>dress up</u> for the contest just like you would for a concert at school. Remember that you want to impress the judge in a way that shows you recognize the importance of looking professional for the contest! **Appearance and behavior** *do* **make a difference.**
