

# ANNUAL FEES FOR ALL STUDENTS - \$44.00

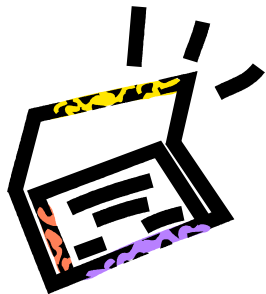
For materials, basic supplies, consumables

Please note: The fees must be collected from each student and are not optional. When checks are written the first day of school, please include student's full name and room number on the check.

Waiver of fees: School fees may be waived for students in need of financial assistance. Generally, the standard used for waiver is eligibility for free or reduced school milk.

Applications for this eligibility are sent home at the beginning of the year. An additional form may be

requested at the office.

## Tennis Shoes

Students have time scheduled for fitness instruction weekly. For safety reasons, we would like the children to wear tennis shoes on fitness day. Miss Leonard asks that the girls wear shorts or slacks on fitness education day. You may wish for your child to keep a pair of tennis shoes at school for fitness day and to change into during "boot weather".

## Book Bags

To encourage children to safely carry home library books, school communications, as well as their own papers, art projects, etc., they should have a backpack or book bag (plastic, cloth, etc.). It should be LARGE, have his/her name on it, and be carried daily. Experience has taught us that those with large envelope closings with Velcro, snaps or zipper closures are most satisfactory.

## Marking Clothing

It is important for you to mark clothing likely to be mixed up, such as raincoats, sweaters, boots, mittens, and caps. A permanent black marker is good to use. Often there are only slight differences, if any, and identification will save time, trouble, and even tears.

Please ask your child about his/her supplies. They will need to be replenished during the year.

## Kindergarten Supplies:

The following items will be included in the PTA School Supply Fundraiser. If parents choose not to participate or after the May 2010 deadline, the supplies need to be purchased outside of school and brought the first day of school:

- \* 2 boxes of 8-large crayons
- \* 2 bottles of school glue, washable 7-5/8 oz white
- \* Box of Kleenex
- \* Headphones (compatible with basic computer headset jack) in a Ziploc bag labeled with name
- \* 2 Laddie Beginner Pencils (no eraser)
- \* 2 folders (one red/one yellow)

### Additional Supplies Needed:

- \* Book bag or backpack
- \* Tennis shoes for fitness education days

- \* Crayola Washable Markers (8 Pack)

## 1st Grade Supplies:

The following items will be included in the PTA School Supply Fundraiser. If parents choose not to participate or after the May 2010 deadline, the following supplies need to be purchased outside of school and brought the first day of school:

- \* Crayons - A box of 16 - Big boxes are too unmanageable
- \* Elmer's White Glue – 1-8 ounce and 2 large glue sticks (1.27 oz.)
- \* 2 Erasers - large
- \* 3 sturdy folders with **bottom pockets - please no side pockets.**
- \* 1 spiral notebook (8 1/2" x 11") wide rule -- not 5-subject or trapper keeper
- \* 10 pencils (#2) with erasers - sharpened
- \* 1 pair scissors (with points)
- \* Colored pencils- pre-sharpened package of 12
- \* Washable markers
- \* Freezer bag for art supplies (will need to be replaced as it wears out)
- \* Art box - **Large (approx 5x13)**
- \* 2 packs of 3X3 Post-it Notes
- \* Ziploc Freezer Bags- (Girls- gallon size/ Boys- sandwich size)
- \* 4 dry erase markers (Low Odor, Fine Tip Expo)
- \* Pencil sharpener (hand held)
- \* Ruler (with inches and cm)
- \* Disinfectant wipes
- \* Box of Kleenex - **family size**

### Items from home to be sent with your child on the first day of school

## 2nd Grade Supplies:

The following items will be included in the PTA School Supply Fundraiser. If parents choose not to participate or after the May 2010 deadline, the following supplies need to be purchased outside of school and brought the first day of school:

- \* 8 Pencils with erasers – sharpened
- \* Colored pencils
- \* Crayons (16-24 colors) **larger sizes do not fit easily in desks**
- \* Crayola markers - washable, please.
- \* Elmer's Glue - 8 ounce (not colored)
- \* Glue Stick
- \* Ruler (12" -inches and centimeters)
- \* 2 Erasers
- \* Art box - **No larger than 8"x 6"**
- \* 2 - folders with pockets – any color
- \* 4 - folders with pockets – **1 plain red; 1 plain blue; 1 plain yellow; 1 plain green**
- \* 2 - Spiral notebook tablets - 10 1/2" x 8" - at least 60 sheets
- \* Quality scissors - 6" or less
- \* Pencil sharpener – with attached container for shavings
- \* Box of Kleenex

### Items from home to be sent with your child on the first day of school

- Girls A-M -Liquid hand soap
- Girls N-Z - Hand sanitizer
- Boys -Disinfectant wipes
- Tennis shoes for fitness education days
- Book bag or backpack
- Paint smock - or - old shirt (no t-shirts, please. An old button shirt works best; cut sleeves to fit so they do not hang down)
