All helmets are made by **Prorider Inc.** and are tested to meet the stringent helmet standards of the US Consumer Product Safety Commission and the Snell Memorial Foundation (<http://www.smf.org>). Please see their websites for other product information or questions (<http://www.prorider.com>).



To be effective, helmets must fit correctly. **Never** buy a helmet that a child must "grow into." Each size helmet fits a range of head sizes. Use a tape measure to measure your child's head one inch above the eyebrows and record the measurement below. The helmets come with foam pads or turn rings to "fine tune" the helmet fit.
