RESOLUTION TO APPROVE ACCEPTANCE OF BIDS FOR ROCKY RIVER CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT'S DISTRICT-WIDE TECHNOLOGY PACKAGE (BID ITEM NOS. 01, 02 AND 03)

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District has advertised for bids for the Rocky River City School District District-Wide Technology Package Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, on August 9, 2011, sealed bids were received publicly, opened and read; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education's construction manager, Project and Construction Services, Inc., and architect, Burt Hill, have jointly recommended the acceptance of certain bids for the Project in a letter dated August 18, 2011 which is attached hereto as Exhibit A1; and

WHEREAS, a tabulation, as shown in Exhibit A2, was made of such bids received;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District, Cuyahoga County, that the bids will be accepted as follows:

- Section 1. That the base bids of Mid-West Telephone Service, Inc. for Bid Item #01 (Structured Cabling) in the amount of \$364,330.00 is hereby determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bid received pursuant to the Board's advertisement for submission of the proposals, and such bid is hereby accepted.
- Section 2. That the base bids of Mid-West Telephone Service, Inc. for Bid Item #02 (Audio/Video) in the amount of \$224,000.00 together with Alternate T-5 (Rocky River High School Sound Reinforcement Systems) in the amount of \$26,817.00 for a total contract in the amount of \$250,817.00 for Bid Item #02 is hereby determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bid received pursuant to the Board's advertisement for submission of the proposals, and such bid is hereby accepted.
- Section 3. That the base bid of Digital Security Systems for Bid Item #03 (Security) in the amount of \$152,619.00 is hereby determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bid received pursuant to the Board's advertisement for submission of the proposals, and such bid is hereby accepted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there be taken from the Building Fund a sum not to exceed \$767,766.00 for payment of said work, subject to confirmation by the Treasurer as to the availability of funds.

Dear Dr. Shoaf:



Eight (8) total bids, including one (1) combination bid, were received on August 9, 2011 for the District-Wide Technology Package. This package was broken down into the following three (3) Bid Items: Structured Cabling, Audio/Video and Security. The total of the low bids is below the bid aggregate published estimate by Seventy-nine Thousand, Eight Hundred Forty-One dollars, (\$79,841.00), and may be awarded. After consultation with the School District, it is recommended that only Alternate T-5 for the classroom sound reinforcement systems at the Rocky River High School be awarded at this time. With the award of Alternate T-5, the low bids remain \$53,024.00 under budget.



The combination bid from Mid-West Telephone Services, Inc. for Bid Items #01, #02 and #03, including Alternate T-5, totals \$803,617.00. This combination bid exceeds the sum of the individual apparent low bids for the three (3) Bid Items by \$35,851.00. Therefore, this combination bid is not being recommended for acceptance.
