Mr. Markus provided a short review of the fiscal year ended June 30, 2010. The District, through revenue stabilization and continued cost cutting and containment methods, was able to end the year with a General Fund balance of \$300,000 more than expected. This will go towards helping the District stabilize the budget for fiscal year 2010 in the event of a revenue shortfall and/or unanticipated expenditures.

The District received approval on our 30 day extension request from the Ohio School Facilities Commission for purposes of selling our allocation of Qualified School Construction Bonds. Important dates/events on the bond issue timeline now are as follows:

- -September 1 Bond Rating Conference Call
- -September 6 Receive Bond Rating
- -September 7 Underwriters Begin Marketing Bonds to Potential Buyers (including small/local resident and business owner investors)
- -September 14 Pricing of Bonds Takes Place
- -September 28 Bond Proceeds are received by District
