#### **Policy 5517.01 Reporting Requirement:**

At least semi-annually, the Superintendent shall provide to the President of the Board a written summary of all reported incidents and post the summary on the District web site (if one exists). The list shall be limited to the number of verified acts of harassment, intimidation, and/or bullying, whether in the classroom, on school property, to and from school, or at school-sponsored events.

#### **District Code of Conduct:**

#### Rule J:

**Bullying:** harassment, intimidation, or bullying means any intentional written, verbal, graphic, or physical act that a student or group of students exhibits toward another particular student(s) more than once and the behavior both causes mental or physical harm to the other student(s) and is sufficiently severe, persistent, or pervasive that it creates an intimidating, threatening, or abusive educational environment for the other student(s); or violence within a dating relationship

**Incidents v. Infractions:** One incident can involve one or more infractions of the student code of conduct, i.e., a student can be written up once for breaking one or more rules.
