[] Competency: Select 1 of 4

[] OST – Passing score on Alg 1 and ELA 2 (3+); or 684 cut score after taking 2 times

[] Demonstrate two career-focused activities; students need 1 Foundational (Proficient scores on WebXams, A 12-point industry credential, A pre-apprenticeship or acceptance into an approved apprenticeship program) and 1 Supporting (Supporting Work-based learning, Earn the required score on WorkKeys, Earn the OhioMeansJobs Readiness Seal)

[] Enlist in the Military

[] Complete CCP Math/English

[] Earn 2 seals: 1 state, 1 local

[] State: Science, Citizenship, Military, Industry Credential, Ohio Means Jobs, Technology, Biliteracy, Honors Diploma, and College-Ready

[] Local: Community Service, Fine/Performing Arts, Student Engagement

[] **Future Planning** – The Student will discuss their current planning for their future, including: college research, college applications, vocational or technical education programs, military options or job placement options. The Counselor will help students to identify which college(s) the student is interested in, future career options, and will generate a plan for the student to pursue their goals. Possible future majors/careers?

[] **College Search/List** – Do you have any thoughts or plans at this point? Goal: identify 6-8 schools of interest by end of year. Apply to 4-6 schools during Senior year.

[] **Scattergrams** – based on GPA and test scores, we will evaluate the likelihood of admission to the schools of your choice.

[] **College Visits:** check Naviance for upcoming rep visits; add schools to receive notifications
