courses scheduled, final grades, credit totals (21 required for graduation), and cumulative GPA.

WebXams, A 12-point industry credential, A pre-apprenticeship or acceptance into an approved
apprenticeship program) and 1 Supporting (Supporting Work-based learning, Earn the required
score on WorkKeys, Earn the OhioMeansJobs Readiness Seal)
[] Enlist in the Military
Complete CCP Math/English
[] Earn 2 seals: At least 1 state seal
[] State: Science, Citizenship, Military, Industry Credential, Ohio Means Jobs, Technology,
Biliteracy, Honors Diploma, and College-Ready
[] Local: Community Service, Fine/Performing Arts, Student Engagement
[] Future Planning – The Student will discuss their current planning for their future, including: college research,
college applications, vocational or technical education programs, military options or job placement options. The
Counselor will work with students to identify which college(s) the student is interested in, future career options, and
will generate a plan for the student to pursue their goals.
