RESOLUTION TO APPROVE ACCEPTANCE OF BID FOR THE ROCKY RIVER HIGH SCHOOL PARKING LOT IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District has advertised for bids for the Rocky River High School Parking Lot Improvement Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, on April 30, 2013, sealed bids were received publicly, opened and read; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education's construction manager, Project and Construction Services, Inc., recommended the acceptance of certain bids for the Project in a letter dated May 8, 2013; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District that the bids will be accepted as follows:

- Section 1. That the Base Bid of Ohio Paving & Construction in the amount of \$291,220 and Alternate Bids #1 (\$130,402 for the Wagar Lot), #2 (\$350,589 for the North Stadium Lot), and #3 (\$4,825 for the Basketball Assemblies) for a total award of \$777,036 is hereby determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bid received pursuant to the Board's advertisement for submission of the proposals, and such bid is hereby accepted.
- Section 2. That together with its base and alternate bids, Ohio Paving & Construction bid Unit Price 1 (With Aggregate) in the amount of \$72.50/C.Y. and Unit Price 2 (With On-Site Spoils) in the amount of \$56.00/C.Y. pursuant to the Board's advertisement for submission of the proposals, and such unit price bids are hereby accepted.
- Section 3. That Ohio Paving & Construction shall complete all work on this Project in compliance with applicable law and the relevant wage rates for Cuyahoga County, a copy of said wage rates are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Appendix A;
- Section 4. That the President and the Treasurer of the Board of Education are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a construction contract as described in Sections 1. through 3. herein for the performance of the work for the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there be taken from the Building Fund a sum not to exceed \$777,036 for payment of said work, subject to confirmation by the Treasurer as to the availability of funds.

Unlisted classifications needed for work not included within the scope of the classifications listed may be added after award only as provided in the labor standards contract clauses (29CFR 5.5 (a) (1) (ii)).

The body of each wage determination lists the classification and wage rates that have been found to be prevailing for the cited type(s) of construction in the area covered by the wage determination. The classifications are listed in alphabetical order of "identifiers" that indicate whether the particular rate is union or non-union.

Union Identifiers

An identifier enclosed in dotted lines beginning with characters other than "SU" denotes that the union classification and rate have found to be prevailing for that classification. Example: PLUM0198-005 07/01/2011. The first four letters , PLUM, indicate the international union and the four-digit number, 0198, that follows indicates the local union number or district council number where applicable , i.e., Plumbers Local 0198. The next number, 005 in the example, is an internal number used in processing the wage determination. The date, 07/01/2011, following these characters is the effective date of the most current negotiated rate/collective bargaining agreement which would be July 1, 2011 in the above example.

Union prevailing wage rates will be updated to reflect any changes in the collective bargaining agreements governing the rates.

0000/9999: weighted union wage rates will be published annually each January.

Non-Union Identifiers

Classifications listed under an "SU" identifier were derived from survey data by computing average rates and are not union rates; however, the data used in computing these rates may include both union and non-union data. Example: SULA2004-007 5/13/2010. SU indicates the rates are not union majority rates, LA indicates the State of Louisiana; 2004 is the year of the

survey; and 007 is an internal number used in producing the wage determination. A 1993 or later date, 5/13/2010, indicates the classifications and rates under that identifier were issued as a General Wage Determination on that date.

Survey wage rates will remain in effect and will not change until a new survey is conducted.

WAGE DETERMINATION APPEALS PROCESS

- 1.) Has there been an initial decision in the matter? This can be:
- * an existing published wage determination
- * a survey underlying a wage determination
- * a Wage and Hour Division letter setting forth a position on a wage determination matter
- * a conformance (additional classification and rate) ruling

On survey related matters, initial contact, including requests for summaries of surveys, should be with the Wage and Hour Regional Office for the area in which the survey was conducted because those Regional Offices have responsibility for the Davis-Bacon survey program. If the response from this initial contact is not satisfactory, then the process described in 2.) and 3.) should be followed.

With regard to any other matter not yet ripe for the formal process described here, initial contact should be with the Branch of Construction Wage Determinations. Write to:

2.) If the answer to the question in 1.) is yes, then an interested party (those affected by the action) can request review and reconsideration from the Wage and Hour Administrator (See 29 CFR Part 1.8 and 29 CFR Part 7). Write to:

The request should be accompanied by a full statement of the interested party's position and by any information (wage payment data, project description, area practice material, etc.) that the requestor considers relevant to the issue.

3.) If the decision of the Administrator is not favorable, an interested party may appeal directly to the Administrative Review Board (formerly the Wage Appeals Board). Write to:

4.) All decisions by the Administrative Review Board are final.
