WHEREAS, the federal government has allocated a portion of the national authorized amount of QSCBs to the State of Ohio;

WHEREAS, the Ohio School Facilities Commission (OSFC) is responsible for allocating the authority to issue QSCBs among eligible schools in the State of Ohio applying for such authority;

WHEREAS, this Board is submitting to the electors of this School District at the May 4, 2010 election, pursuant to Section 133.18 of the Revised Code, the question of issuing bonds in the amount of \$42,902,050 for the purpose of constructing, removating, remodeling, adding to, furnishing, equipping and otherwise improving school district buildings and facilities and clearing and improving their sites (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, this Board has determined that the Project meets the QSCB criteria and desires to apply to the OSFC for the authority to issue QSCBs to finance costs of the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of Rocky River City School District, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Authorization to Request Authority to Issue QSCBs. This Board hereby authorizes the Treasurer and Superintendent to make application to the OSFC for authorization to issue QSCBs for the Project in an amount not in excess of the bond issue amount of \$42,902,050 and otherwise in accordance with any limitations that may be required by the OSFC or State law, understanding that such application in no way commits the District to issue such bonds. Prior to the May 4, 2010 election, the Treasurer and Superintendent, each and both, are hereby further authorized to submit a related letter of intent to the OSFC.

Section 2. QSCB Issuance and Provision of Funds. This Board further authorizes the Superintendent and Treasurer to pursue any initial actions that may be necessary to issue QSCBs as authorized by the OSFC, provided that the specific authorization for their issuance will ultimately be made by subsequent resolution of this Board, and to make certain that funds are provided in a timely manner to assist in paying costs of the Project.

Section 3. Certification and Delivery of Resolution. The Treasurer is authorized to deliver or cause to be delivered to the OSFC a certified copy of this Resolution.

Section 4. Compliance with Open Meeting Requirements. This Board finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were held, in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
