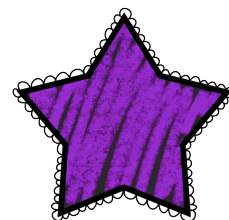
Week at a glance



math	This week we will practice rotating through our math stations. We will learn how to work independently, with partners, in small groups and on our chrome books. On Friday, we will take our first online math timed test!
Reading	In reading workshop, the students will be working towards choosing "just right" books. We will read texts and have a book tasting on Wednesday to identify books that fit our abilities as readers. The students will also help open and label our classroom library, while learning how to use their book boxes.
writing	This week, we will focus on identifying topics for writing. We will be using the watermelon seed analogy to help us develop broad topics, and then focus in on small moments about that topic.
science[®] S.S.	We will begin our first science unit this week! We will be looking closely at how scientists ask questions to help drive experiments. We will be engaging in several experiments this week as we work through the scientific process.
Foundations	As we begin our first Foundations unit, we will review skills such as closed syllables. The students will be responsible for determining the different sounds for: /k/- <u>milk</u> <u>luck</u> <u>cat</u> and /ch/- <u>check</u> <u>catch</u> . Students will be responsible for these concepts and will be tested authentically on Friday. Students are required to complete the Foundations packet and return it on Friday. Completing these weekly packets will help reinforce the skills taught in class and help build competent spellers.

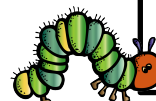
