District Safety Protocols

- Face masks required for all students and staff.
 - Daily cleaning of classrooms, common areas, restrooms, hallways, buses.
 - Weekly building and transportation deep disinfection (electrostatic treatment).
 - Air purification and disinfection in all buildings.
 - Hand sanitizer stations in hallways, common areas, and classrooms
 - Portable sinks in each building for hand washing.
 - Sneeze guards in all main office areas.
 - Sneeze guards and hand sanitizer on buses.
 - Social distancing reminder signage in all buildings.
 - Socially distanced desks in classrooms.
 - All desks facing the same direction.
 - Hand washing reminder signage in all bathrooms.
 - Health self-assessment reminder signage in all buildings.
 - Hands free light switches in buildings.
 - Socially distanced restrooms.
 - Touchless flushers in most bathrooms.
 - Touchless bottle filling drinking fountains in buildings.
 - Regular disinfection of turf at RRHS stadium.
 - Full-time RN added at GPS.
 - Full-time LPN's added at KIS, RRMS, RRHS.
 - No field trips or large group assemblies.
 - No visitors or volunteers in buildings.
- ***Plans are subject to change based on evolving conditions, new information, and recommendations and guidance from public health officials.***

Arrival Routine

Students will meet their classroom teacher in the classroom, rather than on the benches in the lobby. Staff will be assigned to the following locations for safety and supervision: outside, lobby, stairs, hallway, classroom.

Cubbies

There will be a set of eight cubbies for the AM class and a set of eight cubbies for the PM class. AM and PM classes will not share cubbies. We will use every other cubbie to provide distancing.

Entering Classroom

After unpacking, students will wash their hands before meeting on the carpet. Spots are marked on the floor to provide social distancing when students line up at the sink.

Carpet Area/Circle Time

Sit spots will be spaced 3 feet apart. Students will wear masks. A total of 8 sit spots will be placed.

Centers

Center time schedules promote social distancing and allow for washing or switching out of materials before the next group arrives.

2 teacher led centers with 2-4 students per center OR

3 teacher led centers with 1-3 students per center

Snack

Use all four tables for snack time. 2-3 students will be at each table, all facing the same direction. Wash hands prior to and after eating.

Bathroom

Mrs. Beard, Mr. Smith and Mrs. Wagner will have scheduled, staggered bathroom break times so no more than 8 children will be in the boys/girls bathroom at a time.

Echo Room, Outside Blacktop Learning Area, Front yard grass area

These areas will be used for gross motor activities as they provide a big space for social distancing and movement.

Playground

One class will be at the playground at a time.

Sensory Room

A schedule will be created for room use to ensure social distancing.

Reading Time/Classroom Library

Teachers will have 8 different baskets of books to rotate throughout the week.

- Monday AM, PM
- Tuesday AM, PM
- Wednesday AM, PM
- Thursday AM, PM

Free Choice Play

Toys will be rotated between groups and cleaned routinely between groups.

Departure Routine

Students will sit on a marked spot socially distanced in the hallway and wait for their name to be called. Staff will be assigned to the following locations for safety and supervision: outside, lobby, stairs, hallway, classroom

Therapies

OT/PT/SLP will run as normally scheduled one to two children at a time

Guest Reader

A live Zoom Guest Reader will be scheduled each Thursday at the end of the day for family engagement.

Child Becomes Sick While at School

An aide will walk the child to the clinic and call the parent. Parent will arrive, remain in their car, and the aide will walk the child out to the car.

Staff

All staff will enter through either the main office or by PD Center doors and complete temperature screening and health questionnaire. If a staff member becomes ill, they will leave as soon as possible.



Safety Instruction

Teachers will provide safety instruction to include having students avoid touching their mouth, eyes and nose.

Students will be taught proper hand washing and mask handling strategies and receive reminders for the safe use of masks by teachers throughout the day.

Orientation

An orientation video will be created and shared with parents.

Safety drills

Safety drills will be modified to ensure proper social distancing.
