WHEREAS, the official transportation time-study conducted by the Ohio Department of Education on September 25, 2012 conclusively establishes that the Rocky River City School District Board of Education is not legally required by O.R.C. 3327.01 to transport pupils residing in the Kensington Intermediate School attendance area that attend Al Ihsan School.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rocky River City School District Board of Education hereby declares that pupils residing within the Kensington Intermediate School attendance area are ineligible for District-provided transportation to Al Ihsan School located at 6055 West 130th Street, Parma, Ohio 44130.

FIFTH AMENDMENT TQ LEASE AGREEMENT

THIS FIFTH AMENDMENT TO LEASE AGREEMENT is made and entered into as of the 1st day of September, 2012, by and between the Rocky River City School District Board of Education, a duly constituted public school district under the laws of the State of Ohio ("Lessor") and Fairview Hospital, a Cleveland Clinic Hospital and a non-profit medical corporation ("Lessee").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Lessor is the owner of the property generally known as the Wooster School, located at 3035 Wooster Road in Rocky River, Ohio (hereinafter the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, Lessor and Lessee entered into a real property lease dated as of June 16, 1983 with respect to the Property (the "Original Lease"); and

WHEREAS, Lessor and Lessee entered into an Amended and Restated Agreement of Lease dated as of the 1st day of February, 1986 (the "First Restated Lease") with respect to the Properly which amended and modified the Original Lease; and

WHEREAS, Lessor and Lessee entered into a Second Amended and Restated Agreement of Lease dated as of the 17th day of November, 1994 (the "Second Restated Lease") with respect to the Property which further amended the Original Lease; and

WHEREAS, Lessor and Lessee entered into a Third Amended and Restated Agreement of Lease dated as of the 1st day of July, 2002 (the "Third Restated Lease"); and

WHEREAS, Lessor and Lessee entered into a Fourth Amendment to Lease Agreement dated as of June 21, 2012 (the "Fourth Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, the Original Lease, as amended by the First Restated Lease, Second Restated Lease, Third Restated Lease and Fourth Amendment shall hereinafter be collectively referred to as the "Lease"; and

WHEREAS, Lessor has determined that the Property is not presently needed for school purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Term of the Lease expired on August 31, 2012, and the parties hereto have agreed to extend the Term through August 31, 2017,

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and promises and covenants set forth hereinbelow, the parties agree that the Lease shall be amended and/or supplemented as follows:

- The Term of the Lease is hereby extended for an additional period commencing July 1, 2012 (the "Effective Date") and ending August 31, 2017 (the "Fifth Extended Term").
- Commencing on the Effective Date and continuing through August 31, 2017, Lessee's Base Rent shall be \$171,396.15 per annum, payable in monthly installments of \$14,283.01.
- 3. Lessee is hereby granted the option, to be exercised by written notice given to Lessor not later than July 31, 2016 to extend the Term of the Lease for one (1) additional five (5) year extended period (the "Sixth Extended Term"), upon the condition, however, that on the date of exercise of such option with respect to the Sixth Extended Term and on the date of commencement of the Sixth Extended Term, the Lease is in effect and has not expired or been terminated and Lessee is not in default in the performance of any of its obligations under the Lease (constituting a breach of a substantial obligation) as to which a notice of material default has been given to Lessee and which material default thereafter remains uncured.
 - The Sixth Extended Term shall be upon the same terms and conditions as provided in the Lease for the Fifth Extended Term except that (a) the Base Rent for the Sixth Extended Term shall be increased to \$197,105.57 per annum, payable in monthly installments of \$16,425.46, (b) Lessee shall have no option to extend the Term beyond the expiration of the Sixth Extended Term and (c) the leasehold improvements will be provided in their then existing condition ("as is") at the time the Sixth Extended Term commences.
- 4. Subparagraph 5(d) of the Lease is hereby modified by deleting the phrase "except as set forth in Section 5(g) hereof" and placing a period after the word "Premises".
- 5. Subparagraph 5(g) of the Lease Is hereby deleted in its entirety.
- 6. Subparagraph 6(b) of the Lease is hereby modified by adding at the end thereof the following:

"... and repair, ordinary wear and tear excepted, damages by fire or other casualty excepted. Lessee further agrees that it shall also be responsible, at Lessee's sole cost and expense, for any replacements it deems necessary for the safe, efficient or

tenantable operation and functioning of the Property, including, but not limited to, the roof; the Building structure; the Building's parking lot, sldewalks, driveways, steps, excavations, and all appurtenances; all improvements, alterations, additions, equipment, and facilities installed in and on the Building or Property; and the Building's mechanical and utility systems (e.g., HVAC, electrical, plumbing, fire suppression, communications). Lessee will complete such replacements in a firstclass manner using state-of-the-art replacement systems, equipment and materials. Prior to commencing any such replacement(s), Lessee shall provide to Lessor: (a) written notice and a detailed description of the proposed replacement(s); and (b) a period of at least thirty (30) days to review the proposed replacements, except in cases of a bona fide emergency. Lessee shall make any replacements, changes or alterations in or on the Building or Property required by the codes or regulations of any governmental body exercising jurisdiction over the Property. Lessor hereby consents to the expansion and/or improvement of the existing parking lot serving the Building by Lessee, at such time as Lessee shall elect and at Lessee's sole cost and expense."

7. Section 8 of the Lease is hereby modified by adding the following new sentence to the end thereof:

"Lessor shall take no action during the Term hereof with respect to the Property or the Building, the result of which would eliminate the current real estate tax exemption for the Property and the Building."

8. Section 9 of the Lease is hereby modified by adding "replacements," after the first word in the second sentence and by deleting the following from the end of the second sentence:

"... provided, however, the Lessor may request that the Leased Premises be returned to its condition as of the commencement date, in which event Lessee shall cause the Leased Premises to be returned to its original condition." and placing a period after the word "Premises."

- 9. Section 12 of the Lease entitled "Termination" Is hereby deleted in its entirely.
- 10. Section 17 (a) is hereby amended to: Rocky River City School District Board of Education, c/o Superintendent, 1101 Morewood Parkway, Rocky River, Ohio 44116.

- 11. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 20 to the contrary, Lessor hereby agrees that so long as Lessor and Lessee continue in good faith to negotiate and finalize the Lease extension contemplated hereby, that Lessor shall not charge Lessee with the 125% holdover Rent set forth In Section 20; provided, however, that if this Amendment is not executed and delivered by and to the respective parties hereto within a reasonable period of time, after good faith efforts by each of them, then the 125% holdover Rent described in Section 20 shall be payable by Lessee for the period of time between September 1, 2012 and the date on which Lessee vacates the Leased Premises.
- 12. Lessor and Lessee acknowledge and agree that the two (2) outbuildings ("Sheds") placed on the Property by Lessor may remain on the Property during the Term hereof, as the same may be extended, without compensation to Lessee but at the sole risk of loss or damage to Lessor. Lessor further agrees that it shall not replace either of the Sheds, shall maintain them in a sightly and safe condition and shall not install any additional outbuildings on the Property.
- 13. Except as amended and/or supplemented herein, the Lease shall remain unchanged and In full force and effect.
