The following is an overview of the February 11, 2010 Regular Meeting of the Board of Education.

Action

- ∞ The Board passed a Resolution Determining to Proceed with the Submission of the Question of the Issuance of School Improvement Bonds in the Aggregate Principal Amount of \$42,902,050 to the Electors of the Rocky River City School District.
- ∞ Mr. Markus presented the Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) and recognized Student Artists whose artwork was part of the CAFR.
- ∞ The Board passed resolutions approving the January 2010 Financial Statement and Intrafund Transfers for General Accounting; Resolution to Amend Appropriation; Resolution to Approve Then and Now Certificate.
- ∞ The Board passed a Resolution to Appoint Public Records Designee.
- ∞ Retirements and Resignations, Supplemental Duty Appointments and Adjustments in Salary and Assignments were approved.
- ∞ The Board approved a Resolution to Approve the Rate of Pay for Long Term Substitute Teachers.
- ∞ The Board approved a Resolution of Intent to Participate with Ohio Schools Council in Cooperative Purchasing of Buses.
