Superintendent's Update – Dr. Michael Shoaf

Rocky River High School staff presented Freshman Mentoring. This will be a new class for the 2010-2011 school year. The class will take place during the 24-minute seminar period Monday through Friday, the first semester for incoming freshmen. There will be 7 upper class mentors for every 20 students. The text that will be used is 7 Habits of Highly Effective Teens.

- ∞ Dr. Dianna Foley sent out the first test sample for AlertNow. There are still a few email addresses we haven't received. The district hit the 1 million page view on our website. The 2010-2011 school year will begin with a "Google Apps" account for all students. This will allow students to save school files on their Google account as opposed to using a USB Port.
- Ms. Anderson announced the OGT results. All five tests were 90% or better. A thank you to all teachers, as well as Mrs. Megan Rose, who organized the administration of the tests at the high school.
- ∞ Ms. Anderson discussed Resolution #16 Authorizing Application for Credit Flexibility Full Implementation Waiver for the 2010-2011 school year. Rocky River City Schools will apply for a one-year waiver for the educational options component of the district's Credit Flexibility Plan.
