Superintendent's Report

- Ms. Anderson reported that:
 - o Rocky River City Schools were represented by several teams at the 2016 Destination Imagination competition in Beachwood, Ohio. Two of those teams went-on to the state DI Tournament.
 - o RRHS teacher Joanne Ritschel was a recipient of the Greater Cleveland Council of Teachers of Mathematics award for teachers in grades 9-12.
 - We wish to increase the world language department FTE by 0.14 FTE for the 16-17 school year.
- Ms. Norman reported that:
 - o RRSCD will open five (5) preschool sections for the 2016-17 school year;
 - o she submitted another preschool waiver request to the State;
 - o the Rocky River Kiwanis have donated a retrofitted trike to a special needs student in Rocky River.
- Dr. Foley reported that:
 - the RRHS Makerspace and the RRMS Makers Club participated in the District Art Show Opening Night;
 - o teacher Christina Bright took eight of her computer science students on a field trip to the Get IT Here Summit that laid out a clear path for them to pursue and land an IT career;
 - o the annual bicycle fair will take place on April 26, 2016 from 6-7:30 PM at the middle school.
