Superintendent's Report

- Ms. Anderson reported that:
 - o Rocky River High School earned an award from the Ohio State Board of Education for achieving all A's on the state report card.
 - Rocky River High School teacher Sara Ziemnik was named the Ohio Lottery's Partners in Education Teacher of the Month award. The Partners in Education Teacher of the Month award recognizes outstanding K-12 teachers and faculty for their excellence in the classroom, leadership, creativity and community involvement and dedication on behalf of Ohio students.
 - o Rocky River High School teacher Ann Brokaw will travel to Mozambique's Gorongosa National Park in Africa. The trip, July 6 through 18, is sponsored by the Howard Hughes Medical Institute's BioInteractive initiative and will help develop educational programming for university professors and high school teachers to start really thinking about developing sustainable and transformative educational experiences for the Mozambican people.
 - Dr. Dianna Foley won the 2016 WVIZ Betty Cope award. Every year, WVIZ / PBS Ideastream Education honors a member of its Steering Committee with the Betty Cope Award, named after WVIZ's very first programming chief and general manager. Dr. Foley was recognized for her continuing work in contributing to the professional learning and programming of Ideastream education.
