The following is an overview of the December 15, 2011 Regular Meeting of the Board of Education.

Action

- The Board approved the Resolution to Establish the 2012 Organizational Meeting on 1.11.12.
- The Board approved the Resolution to Appoint President Pro-Tem Scott Swartz to Serve as President until a new President is Duly Elected.
- The Board approved the Resolution to Appoint Vice President Pro-Tem, Kathleen Goepfert to Serve as Vice President until a new Vice President is Duly Elected.
- The Board passed Resolutions approving the November 2011 Financial Statement and Intrafund Transfers for General Accounting and a Resolution to Amend Appropriations.
- The Resolution to Request to Receive Advances on Tax Settlement Amounts from the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer for Calendar year 2012 was approved.
- A Resolution to approve Retirements and Resignations was approved.
- The Board approved Resolutions for Approval of Appointments.
- The Board approved a Resolution to Approve Change Management Items.
- The Resolution to adopt the 2013-2014 School Calendar was approved.
- The Board approved a Resolution for an Overnight Competition for the RRHS Cheerleaders to Kalahari Resort on 2.11.12 returning on 2.12.12.
- The Board approved a Resolution for the 8th Grade Class Overnight Field Trip to Washington D.C. on June 4, 2012 returning June 6, 2012.
- A Resolution to approve Course Catalogs was approved.
- The Board approved a Resolution to Accept Gifts to Schools.
- A Resolution to Adjourn was approved.

Superintendent's Report

- Rocky River High School was nominated for the National Blue Ribbon Award for 2012. The application is due 3.2.12.
- Dr. Foley reported on the Chromebook Pilot. Three classes at the Middle School are using Chromebooks. The majority of students would like to use Chromebooks on a regular basis.
