WHEREAS, during his tenure with the Board, Rocky River High School and Rocky River Middle School were named Blue Ribbon Schools of Excellence, Goldwood was named a Hall of Fame School, Kensington won a "Best Practices" award, Rocky River High School earned two Silver Medals from US News and World Report Magazine, and the Rocky River City Schools earned an Excellent with Distinction rating for two years in a row from the Ohio Department of Education; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Schieda was instrumental in promoting three operating levies and two bond issues such that they were approved by the voters; and

WHEREAS, during his years as a Board member over 4,400 different K - 12 students have benefited from his dedicated service to the Rocky River City Schools;

11. Treasurer's Report – Mr. Markus

a. Resolution to Approve Financial Statement and Intrafund Transfers for General Accounting – November 2009

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District, that the Treasurer of Cuyahoga County is hereby requested to pay to the Treasurer of this Board any money from all tax revenues collected and deposited into the county treasury to the account of this Board and lawfully applicable to the purpose of calendar year 2009.

encumbrance, the taxing authority can authorize the drawing of a warrant. The taxing authority has 30 days from the receipt of such certificate to approve payment by resolution or ordinance.
