Dear Parents/Guardians:

The health and well-being of our students and staff is my top priority, and we will do everything possible to make our school environment safe.

The Rocky River City School District has been working closely with the Cuyahoga County Board of Health (CCBH) regarding the Ebola situation. We are monitoring recommendations by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and will institute them as necessary.

Surfaces in the district (desks, counters, chairs, computer labs etc.) are wiped down with a disinfectant solution on a daily basis. Hand sanitizers are available for student and staff use throughout the buildings. We will make disinfectant wipes available to use on Chromebook keyboards. We are also instituting a daily wipe down of school bus interiors with a disinfectant solution.

The Cuyahoga County Board of Health is emphasizing these preventive measures:

- Wash hands as often as possible; hand sanitizers are also helpful
- Do not send students to school when sick
