a. Resolution to Approve Financial Statement and Intrafund Transfers for General Accounting - January 2010

WHEREAS, the Board of Education passed Resolution \#8-10 to dispense with the Listing of Warrants; and

WHEREAS, the funds for payment of these vouchers are included in the 20092010 Appropriation; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee has reviewed the Financial Statement, Appropriation Expenditure Summary Report, and the List of Bills;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District that the Financial Statement and intrafund transfers in the amount of $\$ 52,746.56$ for January 2010; to be included in the minutes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Financial Statements (Exhibit A) also be included in the Minutes and that the Appropriation Expenditure Summary Report and the List of Bills be filed in the Treasurer's Office for Audit.
b. Resolution to Amend Appropriation

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District that the amount of the amended appropriation for all funds as of January 31, 2010 is $\$ 39,058,170$, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the current Certificate of Resources (Exhibit B) in effect identifies sufficient resources to operate the education program for Fiscal 2010 (July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010).

## c. Resolution to Approve Then and Now Certificate

WHEREAS, the requirements of ORC Section 5705.41(D) state that no orders or contracts involving the expenditure of money are to be made unless there is a certificate of the fiscal officer that the amount required for the order or contract has been lawfully appropriated and is in the treasury or in the process of collection to the credit of an appropriate fund free from any previous encumbrances; and

WHEREAS, ORC Section 5705.41(D) provides an exception that, if the fiscal officer can certify that both at the time that the contract or order was made and at the
time that he is completing his certification, sufficient funds were available or in the process of collection to the credit of a proper fund, properly appropriated and free from any previous encumbrance, the taxing authority can authorize the drawing of a warrant. The taxing authority has 30 days from the receipt of such certificate to approve payment by resolution or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Then and Now Certificates submitted to the Rocky River Board of Education (Exhibit C) be approved and that the Treasurer is hereby authorized to draw a warrant for the orders or contracts associated with such certificates as soon as reasonably possible.

## d. Resolution to Appoint Public Records Designee

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District that Greg R. Markus, Treasurer, be appointed as the "public records designee" per ORC Sec. 109.43 for each current member of this Board in accordance with the requirements of Ohio HB. 9 effective on September 29, 2007.
e. A Resolution Determining to Proceed with the Submission of the Question of the Issuance of School Improvement Bonds in the Aggregate Principal Amount of $\$ 42,902,050$ to the Electors of the Rocky River City School District

WHEREAS, on February 3, 2010, this Board adopted a resolution declaring the necessity of submitting to the electors of this School District the question of the issuance of bonds (the Bonds) in the aggregate principal amount of $\$ 42,902,050$ and the levying of a tax to provide for the payment of the debt charges on the Bonds and any anticipatory securities at an election to be held in the School District on May 4, 2010, a copy of which resolution was certified to the Cuyahoga County Auditor; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Auditor has certified to this Board that the total tax valuation of the School District is $\$ 715,629,380$ and the estimated average annual property tax levy throughout the stated maximum maturity of the Bonds that would be required to pay the interest thereon and retire the principal thereof over 34 years is 3.2 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to 32 cents for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Board determines to proceed with submitting to the electors pursuant to Section 133.18 of the Revised Code, at an election to be held on May 4, 2010, the question of issuing Bonds in the amount of $\$ 42,902,050$ for the purpose of constructing, renovating, remodeling, adding to, furnishing, equipping and otherwise improving school district buildings and facilities and clearing and improving their sites, and levying a tax to pay the debt charges on the Bonds and on any notes issued in anticipation of the Bonds. The average annual property tax levy required to pay those debt charges has been estimated by the County Auditor to be 3.2 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 32 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation.

Section 2. The Treasurer of this Board is authorized and directed to certify to the Cuyahoga County Board of Elections not later than the close of business on Thursday, February 18, 2010: (i) a copy of the resolution adopted by this Board on February 3, 2010, declaring the necessity of the bond issue and providing for the principal of the Bonds to be paid over a maximum of thirty-four (34) years, which number of years is hereby certified to the Board of Elections; (ii) the certifications of the County Auditor as to the total tax valuation of the School District and the estimated average annual property tax levy; and (iii) a copy of this resolution. This

Board hereby requests that the Board of Elections give notice of the election and prepare the necessary ballots and supplies for the election in accordance with law.

Section 3. This Board finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken, and all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were held, in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

Section 4. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
