What is going on in:

<u>Reading?</u> We are spending our next few weeks in **Asia**. We'll be reading *Sadako and the Thousand Paper Cranes*, by Eleanor Coerr. The novel is short, but the content is heavy. We will be doing significant preparation before reading this story. Our literature study using folk tales, fairy tales, poetry, and non-fiction will continue this week after Spring Break.

Note: Our **next book report** is due Thursday, April 19th Students will be writing to the author or their books. It is important that the guidelines of the assignment are read carefully. Letters will be mailed as soon as they are graded. How fun it will be as authors start to respond!

<u>Math</u>? In math this week we will be working in Unit 9. We will be practicing **multiplication**, specifically we will be doing activities to help understand the concept of sharing money and making change and we will be learning a wild method of multiplication called "Lattice Multiplication". $3 \quad 5 \quad x$



<u>Science</u>? Our current unit is all about Living Things and how they adapt to their environment in order to survive and reproduce. We'll be continuing our discussion of how animals and plants survive in nature and putting our findings into a formal outline format.

<u>Social Studies</u>? Our current unit is **Economics**. After break we will be preparing for our unit test in economics. The students will receive a study guide early in the week of April 16th and the test is currently planned for the24th. If the class earns an average of 90% or higher, they will have earned the opportunity to have Business Plan Kits available to them. This could change the way Business Time looks to us all. 
- *Concept*: contractions (am and are)
