What is going on in:

<u>Reading?</u> We are finishing our journey to Australia and New Zealand. We'll be finishing the language activity packet that goes with the novel *Nim's Island*, by Wendy Corr, this week.


Note: Our **next book report** due April 19th Students will be writing to the author or their books. It is important that the guidelines of the assignment are read carefully before the book is begun.

<u>Math</u>? In math this week we will be working in Unit 9. We will be on **multiplication**, specifically the partial products algorithm and the traditional method for multiplying two and three digit multipliers. We will also be looking at factors of whole numbers and application of our new skills.

Science? Our current unit is all about Living Things and how they adapt to their environment in order to survive and reproduce.
