


What is going on in:

<u>Reading</u>? We are traveling to Australia and New Zealand. We'll be working with the novel *Nim's Island*, by Wendy Corr, this week. We plan to work on the Lanugage Activity Packet this week and celebrate this continent on Thursday, the 29th.

Note: Our next book report due April 19th Students will be writing to the author or their books. It is important that the guidelines of the assignment are read carefully before the book is begun.

Note: Our next continent will be **Asia**. We will be reading *Sadako and the Thousand Paper Cranes*, by Eleanor Coerr. The novel is short, but the content is heavy. We will be doing significant preparation before reading this story.



<u>Math</u>? In math this week we will be starting Unit 9. We will be going back to **multiplication** for a while to **apply our knowledge of the facts**. We will be multiplying and dividing with multiples of 10, 100 and 1,000. We will be using mental math and we'll explore the connections between multiplication, fractions, and geometry.
