Reading? We are now traveling to Australia and New Zealand. We'll be working with the novel Nim's Island, by Wendy Corr, this week. Our goals will be to find our science curriculum come to life in our novel, to use context clues with words our author made up, and to locate and use some contractions that are also used in thestory.

Math? In math this week we will be working on exploring fractions, placing fractions on a number line, and finding equivalent fractions..


Science? Our current unit is all about Living Things. We will have a test on Thursday where the students will be expected to be able to identify the characteristics of each animal group and give examples of each one (mammal, bird, fish, reptile, and amphibian). In addition, they will have a second chance to share what they know about the life cycles of the frog and butterfly.
