



What is going on in:

Reading? We are traveling to Australia and New Zealand. We'll be working with the novel *Nim's Island*, by Wendy Corr, this week. Our goals will be to identify prefixes and suffixes, define and use some new vocabulary, and find connections between science, social studies, and our reading.
