






<u>Social Studies</u>? Our next unit in Social Studies is local history. We will be looking closely at the timeline of important events in our city's history that have influenced what we are like now.

Opportunity: Make a rubbing of the plaque at Bradstreet's Landing. Bring it in for 300 BCs.






