What is going on in:


Reading? We are spending our next few weeks in Asia. We'll be reading Sadako and the Thousand Paper Cranes, by Eleanor Coerr.

Fundations? *Note: Because of testing, we will work on Unit 12, week 2 starting on May 7th.


Unit: Unit Twelve, week one


Our Star for the week of April 30th is Mrs. Borden!. We look forward to learning more about you!
