




What is going on in: Reading

Book Report information: The Collage Book Report is due May 7th.


As we continue our tour of the world, we are on to our study of Asia! Sadako and the Thousand Paper Cranes by Eleanor Coerr is our next novel. We will be spending this week reading and gaining background information on the culture of many Asian countries through children's literature. We will be reading and studying many folk tales, fairy tales, poems, and non-fiction selections to help us understand the rich traditions of this part of the world. You should know that this novel is set 10 years after World War II and we will be discussing the war and specifically Hiroshima. There are links on our website and some resources I can recommend if you would like to prepare your child for the topic.


Guest Reader: Our guest reader for this week will be Mrs. Sidari. She will be here from 9:15 - 9:30 on April 25th.
