



.Math Multiplication... Advanced!

We are going to learn how to multiply larger numbers together after Spring Break!

39 × 15 45 (5 × 9) 150 (5 × 30) 90 (10 × 9) + 300 (10 × 30)

This is the Partial Products Algorithm.

We will be learning this method and the traditional multiplication method as well. Can you figure out how to do this before you participate in the lesson?

Traditional Multiplication Procedure

Multiply each digit of the smaller number (starting on the right) each digit of the bigger number. Sum the products, carry when necessary.

Science We will continue to spend time noticing how plants and animals survive in the wild. Could a mammal survive in an amphibian's home?










<u>Guest Reader</u>: Our guest reader for this week will be **Mrs. Nieman**. She will be here from 9:15-9:30 on April 11th.
