What is going on in:
Reading
Book Report information: Our new book report will not be handed in to the Hand-In Box! Your child will be reading a non-fiction book (plus any additional sources) about a location he/she would like to visit. He/she will create a postcard, illustrate it, address it, stamp it, and mail it directly to my home. The card will include 5 facts about the location and will be written in first person. Oh, the places you'll go! Books needed to be approved by Feb 8.

We are now studying South America and are reading Salsa Stories by Lulu Delacre. So far we have been to a New Year's party and have watched an alfombra being created.


We will continue to be working on our third writing style this week, Argument writing. The kids will be asked to state an opinion, defend it 3-4 times and then give a counter argument and rebuttal. We will practice this lawyerly style all quarter. Look out for third graders ready to convince you of all sorts of things!

Math? In Unit 7 we will be noticing patterns in multiplication and division and then using the facts to solve more complicated problems that require higher level thinking. Ask your children about where they are "Hanging out on the Bloom's Triangle!".


Science In our second chapter of the Living Things Unit, we will be learning more about plants and animals. This week will will show how plants and animals have physical features that help them survive in their environment. Think about why the feet of an elephant and a tiger are different.


Social Studies. We are continuing our unit on Economics this week. We will be using the McDonald's Corporation to help us make sense of the vocabulary and concepts of this collection of learning targets. This week we will be investigating the concept of opportunity cost. What do you have to give up in order to get what you want most?
