What is going on in: Reading? We are now traveling to Australia and New Zealand. We'll be starting the novel Nim's Island, by Wendy Corr, this week.


Note: Our Collage book report is due March 6<sup>th</sup>.

Up to 5 stuffed animals may visit for free if they arrive with a special tag. The tag must list the animal's *name and species, animal group*, and answer 5 questions: : What is your animal covered with in the wild, how does he/she breathe in the wild? How would he/she have been born in the wild? Is your animal a vertebrate or invertebrate? What are at least 4 examples of other animals in this same group?

- If more than one animal comes to visit in a given day, the group needs s a bag, box, or basket in which to hang out.
- Animals that become distracting must wait in the animal day care center for the remainder of the day and will not be invited back.
- Students may bring in only one animal per animal group per day (mammal, bird, fish, reptile, and amphibian).

Social Studies? Our current unit is **Economics**. We are using McDonald's restaurants and our own classroom economy to help us to understand the concepts of economics. Listen for our vocabulary words: **market** and **competition**.
