What is going on in: Reading

As we continue our tour of the world, we are on to our study of Asia! Sadako and the Thousand Paper Cranes by Eleanor Coerr is our novel. You should know that this novel is set 10 years after World War II and we will be discussing the war and specifically Hiroshima. There are links on our website and some resources I can recommend if you would like to prepare your child for the topic.

Third grade Spring Writing Sample will be completed next week. Your child all third graders will be required to write a one paragraph response to a prompt. They will include a topic sentence, 4 supporting details, and a concluding sentence. Practice at home is encouraged.

Math: Our Unit 10 test will be on Wednesday. Kids will receive their study sheet on Monday. Expect to see: measurement (length, weight, capacity, volume), multiplication, using graphs and charts, fractions review, median and mode.




Other important information?
