## What is going on in:

Reading? We are now studying the continent of North America. We are reading folk tales, fairy tales, poems, legends, and non-fiction from this continent. Our novel will be The Mouse and the Motorcycle, by Beverly Cleary. Many students enjoyed having their own copy of our first novel so that they could respond and predict right in the text as they read. I expect we will begin reading the novel starting on November $7^{\text {th }}$ if you plan to purchase a copy for your child.


Note: Our non-fiction book report has been assigned. The students will read about a location of their choice and send a postcard to my home from the location. The postcard must be postmarked by December $7^{\text {th }}$. See the assignment sheet for more details about the requirements.

Math? We have just started Unit Four. Unit Four is all about multiplication. If you have not started practicing multiplication facts at home, the time has come. We will be practicing here in class in as many ways as I can think of, but nothing can replace the repetition that can be provided at home. The more solid the facts are, the easier the more complex problems will be for your kids. Thank you in advance for helping your child to memorize these facts.

Science? ROCKS!! This week we will be observing and working with rocks.


Social Studies? Our next unit in Social Studies is Government. We will begin working on this unit this week.

Fundations? Because of the short week, we will not be starting a new concept in Fundations. Instead, we will be reviewing concepts from past weeks. I am leaving last week's information in Fridge Facts so you may review at home if you'd like to.
