
What is going on in:

Reading: We are starting a new continent study! We are not traveling far this time as our concentration will be on North America. We will spend about a week looking closely at folk tales, fairy tales, poetry, and non-fiction from North America. We will then move on to our novel, The Secret School, by Avi. This story is set in the 1920s Colorado.

Math? We will be testing on Unit 2 this week. Our topics will include The Trade-First Algorithm for subtraction and adding with 3 or more addends. For your help at home: Trade First is similar to traditional subtraction. The difference is that all the trades happen before the subtraction begins. It looks like this:

trade-first subtraction A method, or algorithm, for subtracting in which all trades are done before any subtractions are carried out.

Example: 352 - 164
