What is going on in:

<u>Reading</u>: We are starting a new continent study! We are not traveling far this time as our concentration will be on North America. We will spend about a week looking closely at folk tales, fairy tales, poetry, and non-fiction from North America. We will then move on to our novel, *The Secret School*, by Avi. This story is set in the 1920s in rural Colorado.

The children will be writing a narrative in class over several days this week. They will not take it home for editing or final fixes, as I will be evaluating these skills. Please continue your writers to do their best because their best keeps getting better!!!

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<u>Math</u>? We will be starting Unit Three this week. Our topics will include standard and metric measurement, how to measure with a ruler, finding perimeter, and creating a line plot with data. **Practice will be required at home to master the ruler.**
