Reading: We are working on our story, The BFG, by Roald Dahl. As we read we are working on our own skills of fluency, comprehension, building vocabulary, and being able to back up our opinions with evidence.

We will be writing our fourth narrative this week. Your children are getting better and better at putting their thoughts into an organized story! Thank you for your help with editing at home as they continue to develop this skill. The more they write, the better they will be able to communicate their thoughts and the less scary that white page will become.

Math? We will be working on Unit 2 this week. Our topics will include addition/subtraction number stories using addition and subtraction. Practicing facts in these operations will make number stories go more quickly and will be easier to solve. Think of facts like the ABCs of math. They are so important to commit to memory.
