What is going on in:


Reading? We will continue reading our novel, The BFG this week. We will be paying attention to the vocabulary, the sequence, the literary elements, and drawing conclusions about the characters, and their motivations as we move through the story.

ALERT! Our first book report was assigned this week and it is due October 20 ${ }^{\text {th }}$. Students need to have their grade 3 or higher chapter book approved by Monday, the $19^{\text {th }}$. For this report the kids will be creating a comic strip that shows the plot of their story in $5-7$ panels.

Math? We are working on Unit two this week. Our topics will include Change-Number-Stories, Comparison Number Stories, The Partial Sums Algorithm, and a Subtraction Algorithm. Science? This week we will be working with our new inquiry vocabulary and science tools. We will have a quiz this week on the steps of the scientific method and the tools that we use in science. Check our notes online, the notes in your child's notebook, or our text book for help. Students should know the 5 steps of the scientific method and be able to identify: graduated cylinder, dropper, thermometer, pan balance, spring scale, measuring tape, measuring cups \& spoons, goggles, magnifying box, and hand lens.

Social Studies? Our first unit in social studies is Maps and Geography. This week we will be discussing important lines of latitude on our planet including the equator, the tropics of Cancer and Capricorn, the Arctic Circle, and the Antarctic Circle. This Thursday we were treated to a presentation by some classmates who created books using the terms we are learning about in Social Studies. We enjoyed your work very much!
