What is going on in:

<u>Reading</u>? We will continue reading our novel, <u>The BFG</u> this week. We will be paying attention to the vocabulary, the sequence, the literary elements, and drawing conclusions about the characters, and their motivations as we move through the story.

ALERT! Our first book report was assigned this week and it is due **October 20th**. Students need to have their grade 3 or higher chapter book approved by Monday, the 19th. For this report the kids will be creating a comic strip that shows the plot of their story in 5 - 7 panels.

<u>Math</u>? We are working on **Unit two** this week. Our topics will include addition with three or more addends and review of addition and subtraction algorithms. We will have a Unit Two Test on Thursday, the 13th of October.

<u>Science</u>? This week we will be taking our first science test. The test will be on Tuesday. Please use the study sheet that went home this week to practice for the test. You may use your notebook, our notes on our web page, and the textbook to help you.

<u>Social Studies</u>? Our first unit in social studies is **Maps and Geography**. This week we will be discussing important lines of latitude on our planet including the equator, the tropics of Cancer and Capricorn, the Arctic Circle, and the Antarctic Circle!
