What is going on in:

<u>Reading</u>: We are working on our story, The BFG, by Roald Dahl. As we read we are working on our own skills of fluency, comprehension, building vocabulary, and being able to back up our opinions with evidence.

In writing this week, we will continue to work on writing narrative pieces. We will be telling stories. A good story has an established situation, a narrator or strong characters who tell the story through words or actions, an organized sequence, characters who respond to situations and each other, words that lead us through the story (first, next, finally, etc), and a clear closure to the problem.

We will be writing our third narrative this week. Your children are getting better and better at putting their thoughts into an organized story! Thank you for your help with editing at home as they continue to develop this skill. The more they write, the better they will be able to communicate their thoughts and the less scary that white page will become.

<u>Math?</u> We are working on **Unit one** this week. Our topics will include identifying patterns, finding differences and preparing for our first test. **Unit One test is Thursday the 20<sup>th</sup>!** A review packet will come home on Tuesday. We will take two days to complete it; the first half will be assigned on Tuesday, the second on Wednesday night.

Science Now that we are feeling comfortable with our science tools and the process of inquiry, we are moving into our Earth science Unit. This week we will be learning about how air and water are in everything... even rocks! We will be observing and investigating several different types of rocks and finding out how they were formed.

Social Studies? We will be looking at parts of maps this week and finding out why they are important (map title, map key, compass rose, and symbols)
