What is going on in:

Reading: We are working on our story, The BFG, by Roald Dahl. As we read we are working on our own skills of fluency, comprehension, building vocabulary, and being able to back up our opinions with evidence.

We will be writing our fourth narrative this week. Your children are getting better and better at putting their thoughts into an organized story! Thank you for your help with editing at home as they continue to develop this skill. The more they write, the better they will be able to communicate their thoughts and the less scary that white page will become.

<u>Math</u>? We are starting Unit 2 this week. Our topics will include addition/subtraction review, fact extensions ($5 \times 2 = 10$ so $50 \times 2 = 100$), patterns in addition and subtraction, and word problems using addition and subtraction. Your kids did very well on their Unit 1 math test. What great mathematicians!

Science: In science this week we will be observing and investigation different kinds of rocks and learning about their properties and origins.

<u>Social Studies</u>? We will work with grid maps and important lines of latitude this week. This would be a great week to play Old Fashioned Battleship... one of the best grid map games around.
